

Title: Expected iPF Series Print Head Life Guideline

Model: iPF500, iPF600, iPF700, iPF5000, iPF8000, iPF9000

Note: This information is intended for end users.

This document describes the guideline of expected print head life derived from Canon internal testing result. The expected print head life testing results contained here are intended for guideline and estimate purposes only and not a guarantee offered by Canon. (For print head warranty information, please read Print Head Warranty section of this document below.) Actual life of print head varies significantly depending on a number of factors such as image duty (coverage), image size, image quality setting, type of media, environmental humidity and temperature, printer/paper profile, printer driver/software/RIP, and other factors.

Number of Prints represents the expected number of sheets that can be printed with a print head or a set of two print heads at the size given. Expected print head life has been determined by our internal testing of the print head using images with 12.5% coverage per color (4 total colors for iPF500/600/700, total coverage 50% image; 11 total colors for iPF5000/8000/9000, total coverage 137.5% image). A1 size is 23.39" x 33.11" (594x841mm) and A2 size equals to 16.54" x 23.39" (420x594mm).
